- This will take time, go over these verses a few times & personalize them.
 - Always know and remember John 6:63, John 8:31-23 & 36 & 1 Cor. 15:45
 - Jesus Words are spirit & life (the very breath & life from God). Revelation, truth & freedom come when believed and applied. Jesus makes you free. Allow Jesus to give you His life giving breath.
 - Go over as often as needed.
 - 1. Mat.6:33 - Seek first God's way of doing it, not your own. Then God's resources are added to you.
 - 2. 2Tim 2:15 - Get in the Word, don't justify yourself, be honest before God, to rightly handle His Word.
 - 3. Heb 12:1-4 Deal with your sin, others did & are enjoying eternity. Look to Jesus who took it.
 - 4. Phil 1:6 Having confidence now, God is doing a good work in you, till you leave to be with Him.
 - 5. Luke 9:23 Want to follow Jesus? Deny self, take responsibility, die to selfishness daily, keep eyes on Jesus, to ever become more like Him.
 - 6. Mark 11:22-26 Faith in God to move mountains and have prayers answered, will require forgiveness of yourself & others. Let it go to God, let the healing come in, no excuses! Faith arises, mountains, move.
 - 7. 1John 1:3-9 & 2:16 A joyous fellowship walk with God will require Jesus blood, honest confession of sin and glorious cleansing of unrighteousness. Thus, restoration back to Jesus our righteousness, so we can walk in His Word and live in fellowship with Him. Then our life shows we are living as Jesus would.
 - 8. Gal 2:20, 4:3-7 & 5:1 We are to live by faith in Jesus who loves us, gave Himself for us. Knowing God as our Father & we His children. Standing firm and strong in this liberty, Jesus has given us.
 - 9. Col 1:12-14, 3:1-4 & 12-17 Begin living a lifestyle of giving thanks to Father God, for delivering us from the darkness of the devils grip, forgiving us our sins and placing us in His Beloved Son's kingdom. Choose daily to set your affections, emotions, feelings and thoughts where Jesus is sitting as our Lord, Savior, King and Peace. Choosing to forgive all who hurt us, or those we carry a grudge about, because we have been forgiven by Jesus. So all of our thoughts, words and actions reflect Jesus name. Then, give thanks to God our Father for His love, mercy and forgiveness and His grace and ability to forgive others.
 - 10. Eph 1:3-7 Knowing we are the blessed of the Lord, in His thoughts from eternity passed. He desired us as His child in Christ. We are now accepted and beloved of God forever.
 - 11. 2Peter 1:2-4 Ever growing in God's grace and peace of who He is and who Jesus is, as our Lord. Knowing we have been given everything of God's life to live godly. Given all of His precious promises. He wants us to partake of them and enjoy them.
 - 12. 1John 4:4, 4:18-19 & 5:4-5 Knowing we are never alone. God loves us, lives in us, and mightier than all. Because Jesus is our Savior, we don't live in fear but in God's perfect love. Giving us the ability to love others, just as Father God loved us. Because we are born of God, His child through our faith in Jesus. He gives us His ability, a faith to overcome and be victorious over all things we face in this world.
 - 13. Rev 12:11-12 Begin to grasp the reality of the "now" of your salvation in Jesus. The Holy Spirit's person, presence, power. Having available all the resources of Father God's kingdom and the authority of Jesus. This gives you the ability to overcome the devil, by Jesus blood victory on the cross and your testimony of what Jesus salvation has done in your life. Jesus blood has freed you from sin, shame, hurt, condemnation, guilt, offense. Free from the devil, from what someone did to you or what you did to someone else. Total and complete forgiveness and freedom, in Jesus Christ redemption Hold to Jesus life and victory in your life until you breathe your last breath. Hallelujah, thank you Jesus!
 - 14. 2 Tim 3:14-17 & 4:1-8 Say; I will stay in the Word, go to the Word, allowing the Scriptures to work their truths into my life. As a result, my faith in God is built up. I'm becoming the complete and mature person of God. I'm being totally equipped to do God's work while here on earth. I'm one who lives the Word I give to others. Even when others don't. I'll look to Jesus as Lord and soon coming judge. Even when others don't want to give ear to the true teachings of Jesus. I'll warn all who will listen, fulfilling the Lord's ministry and doing the work of an evangelist.
