# **S.O.A.R. In God's Word**

## **Guidelines To Follow**

### **Scripture**

God's Word is our first and final authority.

Romans 4:3a For what does the scripture say?

Commit your Bible reading and study to the Lord.

Read the passage prayerfully and slowly.

Be sensitive to the Holy Spirit.

Pay attention to a verse, phrase or a specific word that stands out.

Underline it or jot down the reference verse, phrase or word location.

### **Observation**

What is the writer or speaker saying?

What is being communicated to the intended listener?

What is the Lord saying to you?

What are the words, topics or truth standing out to you?

What Holy Spirit revelation of the Word is being shown to you?

### **Application**

Lord Jesus, what are You trying to tell me?

Is there a revelation or truth about God or His Word I need to believe and look into?

Is there a sin to confess, beware of or on the alert for?

Is there a promise of God to claim or learn more about?

Is there an example I'm being shown to become more like or stop doing?

Is there a command or Word I'm to embrace, start doing or learn more about?

Is there something being pointed out to me that needs my attention or need to change?

Is there an attitude, a thinking or behavior that needs to be addressed?

Is there something I need to stop doing or start doing?

### **Response** (Reflection, Prayer and Personal Actions to Accomplish)

Thank Him for His Word and the Bible Study.

Confess anything that was revealed to you, ask for forgiveness and total restoration.

Ask His help for any area that needs to be addressed.

Commit to the Lord any area of change that is needed.

Thank Him for any revelation or promise made known to you.

Ask God for Holy Spirit wisdom, guidance, to live out what you just received.

Finish with adoration and worship for learning about who He is & His love for you.
