Psalms 122:1 Hebrews 10:25	I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the Lord. Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some [is]; but exhorting [one another]: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.
I Thess. 5:12-13	And we beseech you, brethren, to know them which labour among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you; And to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake. [And} be at peace among yourselves.
Matthew 18:19-20	Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, There I am in the midst of them.
I Corinthians 16:1-2	Concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye. Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.

Jeremiah 3:15	And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.
Romans 10:17	So then faith [cometh] by hearing, hearing by the word of God.
Romans 15:5-6	Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That ye may with one mind [and] one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.
I Corinthians 1:10	I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but [that] ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

John 17:1 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said,

Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify

thee:

John 17:20-23 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me

through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that

thou has sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.

I Corinthians 12:13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether [we be] Jews

or Gentiles, whether [we be] bond or free; and have been all made to drink

into one Spirit.
