John 16:24 Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Romans 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

John 14:13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Matthew 7:7-11 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone? Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent? If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all [men] Liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

Psalms 66:18 If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear [me]:

James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume [it] upon your own lusts.

I John 5:14-15 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hears us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

Hebrews 10:35-36 Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompense of Reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might

receive the promise.

Matthew 14:23 And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone.

Mark 1:35 And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed.

Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.
